HERE ARE SOME TIPS:



PRAY FOR YOUR CHILDREN INDIVIDUALLY.

Every child is unique! God has a specific mandate and call for each and every child. General prayers are great but the more specific you are the better!



ONE PRAYER DOES NOT FIT ALL.

Tailor each prayer to your children's needs. One child may be gifted in music while the other an intellectual. Pray according to their personality and gifts.



WRITE IT ALL DOWN!

You'll feel the Holy Spirit draw things to the surface. He'll begin to reveal things to you about your children that you didn't even know! Write it down and go back and pray for those things often. Look up scripture concerning all that's revealed to you and add them to your list.



PRAY AND FAST ONE DAY FOR EACH CHILD.

If you have 3 kids, you'll take 3 days to pray and fast specifically for them. If this seems like a lot, ask yourself this..."who else will pray and fast for my kid?" No one loves (besides the Lord) or wants the best for your child than you! If you don't do it, no one else will! This will help shape their future. Who they marry, their relationship with the Lord and other people are all depending on you and your fasting and prayer!

DON'T FORGET

Begin your prayer with worship and adoration to the Father. You pray to the FATHER in the name of the SON, Jesus. Who you address your prayers to is vital! Start each prayer session with "Heavenly Father," and finish it with "In the mighty Name of Jesus! AMEN!"





ISAIAH 54:17 (AMP)

"But no weapon that is formed against you shall prosper, and every tongue that shall rise against you in judgment you shall show to be in the wrong. This [peace, righteousness, security, triumph over opposition] is the heritage of the servants of the Lord [those in whom the ideal Servant of the Lord is reproduced]; this is the righteousness or the vindication which they obtain from Me [this is that which I impart to them as their justification], says the Lord."



No weapon formed against (Child's Name) shall prosper. Fill her/his mouth with your Word to cast down all who accuse her/him. Thank you that her/his days will be full of peace, security and triumph over ALL opposition. May you always bring vindication to her/his name. PSALM 112:2 (NKJV)
